


Installation Instructions

60-0502RC Triumph 675 (ALL) Clutch Cover Protector

- 1) Attach the skid plate to the Woodcraft cover by bolting it from the inside. IMPORTANT USE **BLUE THREADLOCKING COMPOUND** ON THE THREE SKID PLATE MOUNTING BOLTS. Coat the threads completely and allow the threadlocking compound to fully set before use.
- 2) The 60-2500 rubber pad should be adhered to the back side of the cover.
- 3) For 2006 to 2012 models, see below before completing this step. Install the Woodcraft cover using the included mounting hardware in the 4 locations shown above. Torque for these mounting bolts is about 7 ft-lbs.



• Bolts 3 & 4: 6 x 50mm



4) Start the motorcycle and inspect for any leaks before riding.

Important note for 2006-2012 Models:

On these first generation 675's the clutch cover and ignition trigger cover need to be removed in order to install the Woodcraft cover protector over the stock clutch cover.

- Remove the ignition trigger cover (the most forward cover)
- Remove the OEM clutch cover
- We recommend replacing the gaskets before re installing the covers. Be sure to clean and carefully inspect the gasket surfaces before installation
- Re-install the clutch cover with the Woodcraft cover in place, then re-install the trigger cover.

Installation of Woodcraft Billet Covers involves removal and reinstallation of certain factory components such as fasteners, alternator stators and oil-retention gaskets.
